

LONDON CHECKLIST

Chronology of Things to Do

Passport—You must have a passport valid through February 2013. To obtain or renew a passport, visit the United State Department of State web site, http://travel.state.gov/passport/get/first/first_830.html

Application fee—If you did not send it with your application, send it immediately.

Letter of Good Standing—If you are not an SULC student, see your registrar.

Nonrefundable Deposit—\$350 is due six weeks after acceptance or 3 May 2012, whichever is earlier.

Financial Aid—Apply to your school immediately. If you are not an SULC student, obtain a “consortium agreement” and send it to SULC’s financial aid office immediately.

For those not using financial aid—The balance of your fees and charges (after the \$350 deposit) will be due by 1 June 2012.

Expenses other than tuition—These must be paid by 1 June 2012. If your financial aid funds will not arrive at by that date, you must coordinate with SULC’s registrar, Mrs. Elaine Simmons.

Travel to London—It is your responsibility to arrange and pay for travel. Explore options early. Plan to depart the US no later than 23 June, and to return no earlier than 4 August.

Visas—United States citizens do not presently need visas to visit the United Kingdom, the Netherlands, or France. Citizens of other countries may need a visa. It is the responsibility of the student to obtain all necessary visas.

Immunizations—Immunizations are not presently required to visit the U.K., Netherlands or France.

Contraband—British law forbids bringing pepper spray or tear gas into England. Even small pocket knives may not be carried on the street in England.

Transportation security—Knives and sharp objects must be carried in checked baggage. Checked baggage should be left unlocked or be locked only with a TSA-approved lock.
